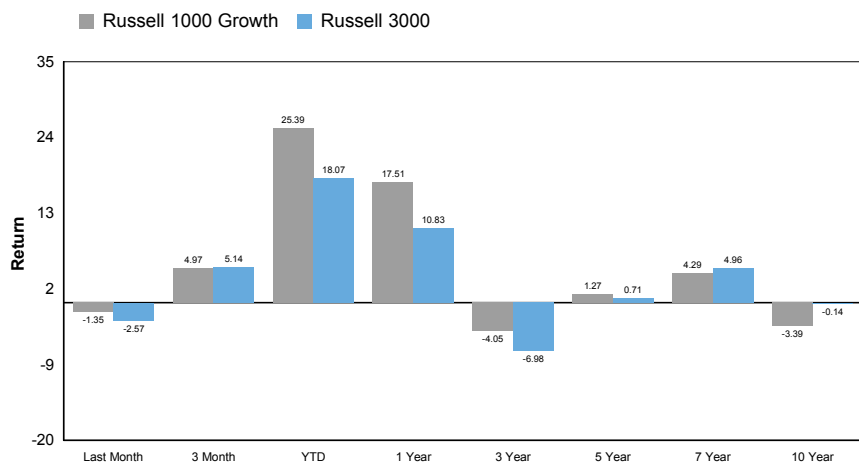


Russell 1000® Growth Index
